Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso shall include all applicable taxes, duties and/or levies payable. 4. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s. 5. The services to be rendered or conducted shall be on a pre-arranged date from receipt of Purchase Order. 6. Representatives from the Medical Unit and Property & Supply Division (PSD) shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods/services to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications 7. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.001%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay.
