1.) 273 pcs of .5 ml Pre-Filled Syringes (PFS) of Quadrivalent Seasonal Influenza Vaccine			
2.) Contains the following WHO (World Health Organization) Southern Hemisphere recommended strains for the 2022 season: > A/Victoria/2570/2019 (H1N1) pdm09-like strain > A/Darwin/9/2021(H3N2)-like strain > B/Austria/1359417/2021-like strain > B/Phuket/3073/2013-like strain			
3.) The sub-distributor should submit the FDA Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) of the product to be used specifically for the agency;			
4.) The product must be maintained in cold chain storage during delivery, with 93 PFS to be delivered on the first day, and 60 PFS each on the 2 nd , 3 rd and 4 th day;			
5.) All needles should be extremely sharp;			
6.) The sub-distributor should provide the following: -Medical team -consent forms -cotton balls -alcohol -band-aid strips/micropore tape -vaccination cards -sharps container			
7.) Administration of the vaccine will be a four (4)- consecutive working day schedule, with 93 recipients on the first day and 60 recipients each on the second, third and fourth day;			
8.) Un-administered vaccines on the first day will be endorsed back for safekeeping and will be brought back on the next scheduled immunization day. The same applies to the un-administered vaccines during the second and third day;			
9.) The medical team consisting of one nurse and one physician should undergo Rapid Antigen test done within 24 hours prior to the first day of vaccination schedule. The negative result of the said test should be presented to the CTA Medical Clinic on the first day of vaccination; and			
10.) The medical team should wear their white medical coat during the entire immunization period.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form.
- 2. Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission.
- 3. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
- 4. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- 5. Any interlineation, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation (for goods and infrastructure) or, the highest rated offer (for consulting services) which complies with the technical specifications and other terms and conditions stated herein.
- 7. The item/s and/or services shall be delivered to the Court of Tax Appeals within five (5) days from receipt of purchase oder. Payment shall be made within seven (7) days upon receipt of the good/s and/or service/s and demand for payment.
- 8. Representatives from the Medical Division (MD) and Procurement and Property Management Division (PPMD) shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity with the technical specifications.
- 9. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.001) of the value of the goods/services not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. The CTA shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
- 10. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by retention money in the amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period. Provided, however, that the goods are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.
- 11. The CTA reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the procurement process, and to reject offers at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Supplier.
