1. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form. 2. Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission. 3. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable. 4. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected. 5. Any interlineation, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s. 6. Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation (for goods and infrastructure) or, the highest rated offer (for consulting services) which complies with the technical specifications and other terms and conditions stated herein. 7. The items shall be delivered to the Court of Tax Appeals on or before June 16, 2023. Payment shall be made within seven (7) days upon receipt of the goods and demand for payment. 8. Representatives from the Office of Administrative and Finance Services (OAFS) and Procurement and Property Management Division (PPMD) shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity with the technical specifications. 9. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.001) of the value of the goods/services not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. The CTA shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it. 10. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by retention money in the amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period. Provided, however, that the goods are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met. 11. The CTA reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the procurement process, and to reject offers at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Supplier.
