TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Supplier shall provide correct and accurate information in this form.
2. The price quotation must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission.
3. Price quotation, to be denominated in Philippine Peso, shall include taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
4. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
5. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your authorized representative/s.
6. Award of Contract shall be made to the lowest offer which complies with the technical specifications and terms and conditions stated herein.
7. The item/s and or service/s shall be delivered and installed within sixty-eight (68) days from receipt of Purchase Order. Replacement of defective item is seven (7) days after testing and commissioning. Supplier agrees to comply with the established health protocols of the CTA.
8. Representative from the General Services Division (GSD) and Procurement & Property Management Division (PPMD) shall have the right to inspect and test the goods to confirm their conformity with the scope of work.
9. Payment shall be made within seven (7) to fourteen (14) days after delivery of the goods and/or services and demand for payment, with complete documentation.
10. The warranty for replacement of parts is six (6) months and one (1) month for the workmanship from the date of acceptance.
11. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by retention money in the amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period. Provided, however, that the goods are free from patent and latent defects and all conditions imposed under the contract have been fully meet.
12. Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (.001) of the value of goods/services not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. The CTA shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
13. The CTA reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the procurement process, and to reject offers at any time prior to the award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Suppliers.

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
