


To avoid difficulty in identifying marked documents, considering that the alphabet consists only of twenty-six (26) letters, majority of the members of the Court En Banc agreed that a different mode of marking documentary evidence shall be adopted, to wit:

1. In civil cases, documentary evidence shall be marked as Exhibits "C-1", "C-2", "C-3" and so on for the complainant or as Exhibits "P-1", "P-2", "P-3" and so on for the petitioner or plaintiff; while documentary evidence for the respondent shall be marked as Exhibits "R-1", "R-2", "R-3" and so on or as Exhibits "D-1", "D-2", "D-3" and so on for the defendant.
2. In criminal cases, documentary evidence for the complainant shall be marked as Exhibits "C-1", "C-2", "C-3" and so on or as Exhibits "P-1", "P-2", "P-3" and so on for the plaintiff; while documentary evidence for the accused shall be marked as Exhibits "A-1", "A-2", "A-3" and so on.
